To celebrate how far he'd come, Alison wanted to buy a special treat for Triston, which was his and Hercules' portrait session.

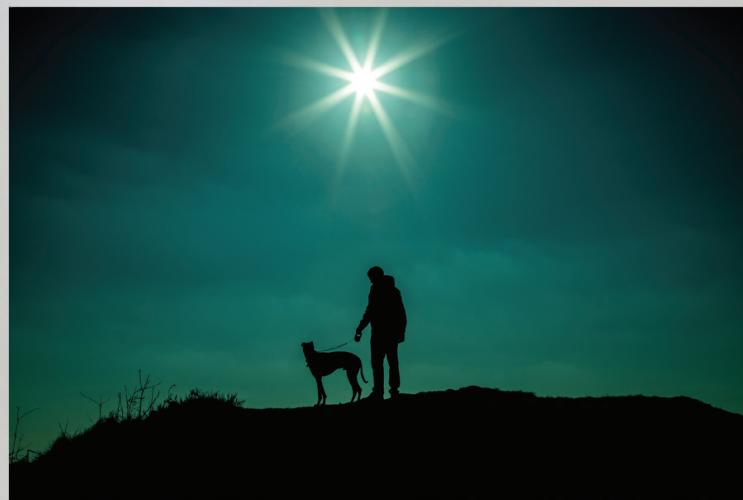
Alison says:
